Singer Tonya Mitchell Partners with National Alliance to Amplify Survivor Voices

The National Alliance of Domestic Violence Survivors (NADVS) is honored to announce a powerful new partnership with acclaimed singer **Tonya Mitchell**. This collaboration stands as a united commitment to amplify awareness of domestic violence in all its forms and to ensure survivors across the nation feel seen, supported, and empowered.

Tonya's decision to share her personal story through her music marks a pivotal moment in the movement to confront the realities of abuse. Her voice—both as an artist and as a survivor—carries the bravery and truth that so many victims are unable to express. By stepping forward, she offers hope to others who have endured similar pain and creates a platform for more open, honest conversations about healing.

Alicia Living, Founder and CEO of the National Alliance of Domestic Violence Survivors, shared, *“Tonya is a survivor that we are proud to call an ally. She has shown courage for sharing her message and truth about her experience, and together, we hope to shed light on all forms of abuse—physical, mental, emotional, financial, and other unseen forms that harm women across the U.S.”*

Through this partnership, Tonya and NADVS will work collaboratively on survivor-centered awareness by offering resources at the end of Tonya's new music video *“Nobody Loves Me Like You.”* Tonya has also generously offered one dollar of every sale in a campaign called Dollar for Deliverance, to be donated to the Alliance in support of survivors of domestic violence.

This alliance between Tonya Mitchell and NADVS underscores a simple but urgent truth: **no survivor should walk their journey alone**, and every story shared helps pave the way for change.

Former pop star country pop artist Tonya echoed Living's comments,

“As a singer and survivor, my mission is to use my voice as both a healing instrument and a catalyst for change. With the release of Nobody Loves Me Like You, a song born from the pain, resilience, and rebirth that follow domestic violence, I stand committed to honoring my truth while empowering others to reclaim theirs. Through my partnership with the National Alliance of Domestic Violence Survivors, I am stepping forward to share my story—courageously, transparently, and with purpose. Together, we aim to illuminate every form of

abuse, seen and unseen, and remind survivors everywhere that their voices matter, their stories matter, and their healing matters.”
